**Title:** School Reform and Democracy in Japan in the Global Era

**Abstract:** In this seminar, I will present an innovative vision of the school reform and democracy by focusing on the hope for learning and living in the global era. Since the 1990s, Japanese educational reform has put emphasis on “zest for living” and has fostered neoliberalism of marketization, liberalization and deregulation. Though Japanese students are likely to get highest scores in the international testing and assessment such as PISA and TIMSS, the motivation for learning is low, and students’ cynicism about learning has been reinforced by social changes such as growing income inequality, sluggish labor markets and social crises. In the global era, the ray of hope for learning and living consists in building educational democracy and equality and enacting school reform based on innovative learning philosophy and methods.
